IMPORTANT / CAUTION

USE BOLT SEALANT



Apply 3 to 4 small drops of bolt sealant onto the cleaned and degreased threads before tightening the bolts.

USE ANTI-SEIZE LEAD-FREE COPPER PASTE (black tube)

Provides trouble-free and long-lasting protection against seizing, corrosion and rusting of bolts, threaded ends, nuts, joints, etc. Also protects against vibration, wear and impact.

WARNING! Avoid eye contact. Avoid excessive skin contact. Keep out of reach of children.



USE ANTI-SEIZING GREASE (white tube)

Prevents seizing, corrosion and excessive wear between the titanium components of your exhaust system.



SERIAL NUMBER POSITION

Unique serial number of the Akrapovič muffler is located on the muffler's inlet.






REMOVAL OF STOCK EXHAUST SYSTEM:

- 1. Put the motorcycle on a central racing stand. Make sure, that surface is solid and flat.
- 2. Unscrew the marked bolts and remove the right side panel (F 01).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this process!




- 3. Loosen the marked clamp and unscrew the link pipe's bracket bolt (F 02).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this process!



- 4. Unscrew the muffler's bracket bolt and carefully remove the muffler off the motorcycle (F 03).
- CAUTION: support the muffler during this process!
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this process!



- 5. Unscrew the two marked nuts and carefully remove the stock header pipe off the motorcycle (F 04).
- CAUTION: make sure not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this process!





INSTALLATION OF THE AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEM:

1. Set up the sleeve together with the flange and springs as shown; make sure you orient the flanges and springs as shown (F 05).



- 2. Install the assembled sleeve, flange and springs onto the motorcycle and hand tighten the two marked stock nuts (F 06).
- ! IMPORTANT: do not fully tighten the nuts yet!
- INSTALLATION TIP: use new stock exhaust port gasket.




- 3. Assemble the carbon fiber heat shield onto the header tube, using Akrapovič bolts and heat resistant washers (F 07, 08).
- INSTALLATION TIP: screw the heat resistant washers onto the bolts; do not try to push them on!
 IMPORTANT: make sure to place the bigger heat resistant washers between the header tube and carbon fiber heat shield and smaller washers between bolts' heads and heat shield!





- 4. Insert the header tube into the sleeve, attach the springs and tighten the nuts to a specified torque (F 09).
- MPORTANT: before tightening the nuts, make sure, that springs pull the header tube all the way into the sleeve use rubber mallet if necessary to tap the connection into place!



5. Assemble the clamp from Akrapovič installation kit onto the muffler's inlet pipe, as shown (F 10).



6. Assemble the aluminium bushes into the rubber muffler's bracket, as shown (F 11, 12).







- 7. Carefully slide the muffler onto the outlet side of the header pipe. Hand tighten the clamp, muffler's bracket (using stock bolt and washer from Akrapovič installation kit), link pipe's bracket bolt (using stock bolt), as shown (F 13).
 - IMPORTANT: do not fully tighten the bolts yet!
- CAUTION: make sure not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this process!



8. Align the muffler in respect to the motorcycle and tighten the muffler's bracket bolt, link pipe's bracket bolt and clamp to the specified torques (F 14, 15).





- 9. Reattach the right side panel and tighten the marked bolts to a specified torques (F 16).
- ! CAUTION: make sure not to damage any part of the motorcycle during this process!





FINAL INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE:

Clean grease spots off all exhaust system surfaces, when installation is finished. Cleaning will prevent spots from burning onto the surface. Do not use aggressive chemical cleaners, because they can damage the surface or sticker.

- 1. Muffler titanium outer sleeve: use a soft cloth sprayed with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40 or equivalent).
- 2. Muffler carbon-fiber outer sleeve: use a soft dry cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 3. Muffler carbon-fiber outlet cap: use a soft dry cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 4. Painted mufflers and parts use a soft cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 5. Chrome plated mufflers and parts: use a soft cloth sprayed with all purpose foam cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 6. Stainless steel pipes: use a soft cloth sprayed with a contact cleaner, then wipe with a soft dry cloth.
- 7. Titanium pipes: use a soft cloth sprayed with a multi-purpose spray lubricant (WD-40 or equivalent).
- INSTALLATION TIP: make sure all the bolts are sufficiently tightened. In case the exhaust system touches the cowling or other parts repeat the adjustment of the exhaust system or contact your authorized dealer!
- INSTALLATION TIP: after running engine for 30 minutes, retighten the bolts of the Akrapovič carbon-fiber heat shield!
- IT IS NORMAL IF WHITE SMOKE COMES OUT OF THE MUFFLER ON FIRST OPERATION.
- A CHANGE IN THE COLOR OF THE EXHAUST SYSTEM IS NORMAL DUE TO THE HIGH TEMPERATURES.
- DO NOT STAND BEHIND THE MUFFLER ON FIRST OPERATION.
- DO NOT USE AUTOMOTIVE WHEEL CLEANERS OR ANY CLEANING PRODUCTS WHICH CONTAIN ACIDIC ADDITIVES TO CLEAN AKRAPOVIČ EXHAUST SYSTEMS.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

Problem	Possible cause	Solution
Exhaust gas leaks out of the muffler/pipe clamp connections	loosened clamp	tighten the clamp to specified torque
	connection is not completely joined	tap the connection into place and tighten the clamp to specified torque
